Section 3: Supplemental (Non-Vacancy Specific) Recruitment Activities Undertaken by Stations KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD:

KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD HAVE ACHIEVED BROAD OUTREACH THROUGH THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS:

- 1. KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD co-sponsored a job fair with Marshalltown Community College/Iowa Valley Continuing Education. This job fair was held on April 6th, 2016. All management personnel of KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD, specifically Mark Osmundson and John Wirkler, participated in the planning sessions and decision making processes for this job fair. KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM AND KTDV-FM also donated over 19 hours of combined air time to promoting this event to encourage employees to have booths at the job fair and the general public to attend the job fair. KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD also staffed a booth at the job fair to make those in attendance aware of positions available at KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD. We also answered general questions about job opportunities in radio and television. In all, Mr. Osmundson and Mr. Wirkler visited with 11 people about positions at KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD as well as careers in radio and television in general.
- 2. CEO and General Manager of KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD, Mark Osmundson, serves on the Board of Directors of the Iowa Broadcasters Association Foundation. During the Applicable Period, two students in the University of Northern Iowa Electronic Media Studies program received \$4,000 scholarships to continue their education at that school. As a Foundation Board of Directors Member, Mr. Osmundson was involved in the review process and selection of the two successful candidates who received the scholarships.
- 3. On October 14, 2015, KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD Station Manager, John Wirkler, conducted a job shadow for a student of the BCLUW School District. This job shadow included a tour of the facilities as well as a detailed discussion of all of the various jobs available at KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD and in broadcasting in general.

- 4. C.E.O. and General Manager of KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD, Mark Osmundson, as well as KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD Station Manager, John Wirkler, are members of the advisory panel for the Broadcasting and Mass Media Studies department at Marshalltown Community College. This panel advises the college on how to improve its training and attract a diverse student base to this area of study at the college.
- 5. On October 14th, 2015, KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD Station Manager, John Wirkler, participated in an E.E.O. webinar made available through the Iowa Broadcasters Association. The webinar was conducted by Mr. David Oxenford of the Wilkinson-Barker-Knauer law firm. The information gained from participation in this webinar was shared with other management personnel in the employment unit comprised of KDAO-FM, KDAO-AM, KRFH-FM, KTDV-FM AND KDAO-CD.
